Subject: Future Limited Partnership – Business in China


Dear President,

People's Republic of China is in the course of considering a draft law allowing limiting liability Partnership i.e. where one or more partners may have un-limited liability.

Company formed under the drafted Law a partner will have following visible benefits apart from others:

- a) No corporate IT has to be paid.
 - b) Investors would not be subjected to double taxation.
 - c) Investment risks can be reduced.
 - d) A partner may make a smaller capital contribution with un-limited liability or vise versa.
 - e) Parties can enter into an agreement with varied-respective rights and obligations.
